

FSC Chain of Custody Group Certification Makes a Big Impact for Small Businesses

Recent changes to our group certification program make it easier and more affordable for smaller companies to earn a chain of custody certification.

Canadian companies with 25 or fewer full-time equivalent employees, or maximum annual turnover of \$5 million CAD, are eligible to join a group certificate.

Group certification is a great option for small businesses because group managers can explain the FSC requirements, help develop internal procedures, and provide a streamlined path to certification. The process helps keeps costs low and provides group members with ongoing support.

WHO NEEDS CERTIFICATION?

Any company involved in the transformation, processing, manufacturing, or distribution of a forest-based product must be FSC certified to apply an FSC label to its products and/or sell them with an FSC claim.
